1) OPEN NIGHT

3) ROOM 9 FLOOR TILE REMOVAL

I am very pleased to report that the company who was employed to remove the floor tiles containing asbestos have done a fantastic job. The four stage clearance inspection has been successful and we have a **passed** a clearance report - Here is the key information from their clearance report;

Clearance Declaration

I, Richard Worthington-Currie, declare that:

- I found no visible asbestos residue or debris from asbestos removal works area, transit route or asbestos waste laydown area.



- The air monitoring shows the respirable fibre level does not exceed 0.01 fibres/ml.
- As far as can be determined from the clearance inspection, the asbestos removal area does not pose a risk to health and safety from exposure to asbestos.
