



TESTING DATES AND INFORMATION FOR YEAR 7 ENTRY TO TE ATATŪ INTERMEDIATE FOR 2023

Dear Parents / Whānau,

To ensure a positive, smooth transition to Te Atatū Intermediate School, we would like to welcome year 6 students to orientation visits on Thursday 3 and Friday 4 November. This will be an opportunity for year 6 students to come and spend some time with us: meeting teachers, viewing and becoming familiar with their new school environment, and making connections with other year 6 and year 7 students, so that they can confidently look forward to starting at Te Atatū Intermediate in 2023!

The visits for Year 6 students coming to us next year are on the following dates:

RUTHERFORD PRIMARY SCHOOL - THURSDAY 3 NOVEMBER 2022, 9.30am-11.30am

MATIPO PRIMARY SCHOOL - THURSDAY 3 NOVEMBER 2022, 12.30pm-2.30pm

PENINSULA PRIMARY SCHOOL - FRIDAY 4 NOVEMBER 2022, 9.30am-11.30am

OUT OF ZONE STUDENTS - FRIDAY 4 NOVEMBER 2022, 12.20pm-2.30pm

We will send a bus to collect students from Rutherford, Matipo, and Peninsula Primaries, and will return students back to school at the conclusion of the orientation visit.

**** Please note: Students from outside of the THREE above mentioned schools, will need to make their own way to and from Te Atatū Intermediate.***

Please note that this year we will not be asking students to sit entrance tests.

Students will need morning/afternoon tea and a drink bottle.

Note from the Office:

If you are handing in the enrolment form on the orientation day – please make sure your child brings “Proof of Residency” for Te Atatū Peninsula. This can be in the form of a power, telephone, sky bill or a rental or mortgage agreement as long as the family name is on it.

This year we will once again meet with the Year 6 Team Leader and teachers from each primary school to discuss each child and work on best fit class placements for next year. We strongly take into account the teachers input at these sessions. We are unable to let parents know the class placements by the end of the term as unfortunately numbers do change right up till the end of the year.
