WHERE:

Carey Park Camp, 397 Henderson Valley Rd, Waitakere, Auckland

WHY:

Camp 3: Kea syndicate (rooms 1, 2, 9, 10, 11) - Monday 24 June - Wednesday 26 June

COST:

The Carey Park experience is \$270, and we would appreciate your contribution to support this EOTC programme.

This includes: meals, accommodation, all activities, and covers the trained instructors. The bus cost will be covered by the school.
