Re: Enrolment scheme at Te Atatu Intermediate School

Since 2018, Te Atatu Intermediate School has an enrolment scheme imposed by the Ministry of Education.

Under this enrolment scheme, the following classifications apply;

Classification 1: In Zone Student Applications. Any student living within the Te Atatu Intermediate School zone (Te Atatu Peninsula) has right of entry to Te Atatu Intermediate. Proof needs to be supplied in the form of a rental agreement or utility bill.

Classification 2: Out of Zone Applications- Any student who lives outside of the Te Atatu Intermediate School zone (***outside of Te Atatu Peninsula – the motorway separates Te Atatu South from Te Atatu Peninsula***) a ballot process as instructed by the MoE and the Board of Te Atatu Intermediate School comes into effect. This means that should there be more applications than places available, a ballot is drawn by a member of the NZ Police.

Please note, this means it is not a 'first in, first served' system. All application names received by the due date are entered into the ballot. Names drawn, up to the designated number of places available, will be eligible to attend once confirmation of the place has been returned. (Notification is sent via mail)

Numbers likely available each year will be advertised on the school website and within the local newspaper as per MoE regulations.

Those outside of the allocated places are then put on a waiting list for any places that may become available. The ballot is drawn in September of each year. All out of zone applications must be in by the 31st August.

The proof of address must be provided that the parents/main caregiver of the child who is enrolling, live in the enrolment zone of Te Atatu intermediate School and so meet the criteria for their child attending Te Atatu Intermediate School.
