M.O.E DONATIONS SCHEME

TAI has opted into the Ministry of Education donations scheme

Therefore, as a school, we do not ask for a school donation. Below is some information for whānau around the donations scheme:

- We cannot charge you for anything involved in the core learning programme (curriculum), including "subject fees"
- We can ask you to pay for goods provided that are optional (for example musical instruments and lessons or Sports Academy)
- You need to provide your child with a uniform which you can purchase from The Uniform Shoppe, 521 Rosebank Road, Avondale. Alternatively, you may buy secondhand elsewhere (online).
- If your child is involved in after-school/weekend sports teams, or after-hours cultural activities, (extracurricular activities) these are optional. If you choose for your child to participate, you may be asked to cover the costs associated with these activities.
- We can ask for payment towards overnight camps. You can make a voluntary donation to your school or kura at any time and if you choose to do this, GST is not payable on the donation and you can claim a tax credit.





CORE SCHOOL LEARNING THE SCHOOL WILL PAY

MATHSBUDDY - TAI pays \$26 per student for this. MathsBuddy is a part of our mathematics programme. It is New Zealand's leading online interactive maths programme that complements what students learn in class, supporting them to achieve top results. Students may work at their own pace, allowing them to pause and rewind the lesson, practice questions online and receive immediate feedback. Teachers and parents receive regular reports to monitor students' progress

CLASS TRIPS - Class trips that relate to core learning within the curriculum will be covered through the donations scheme. Parents will still need to give permission for their child to attend

CURRICULUM EVENTS - Any events such as Life Education, which promotes learning and comes to the school etc will be covered within the donations scheme. Again, parents will still need to give permission for these events

TECHNOLOGY - As technology is part of the curriculum, there will be no costs associated to parents for these activities

I.T - The board provides every student with a Chromebook device, helping make 21st century learning accessible for all students. Devices remain at school

We use Qizzle for our stationery which can be ordered online and delivered to your address or directly to the school (please use your child's name when ordering.)

Each pack contains the list of items below and attracts small rewards to the school for every pack sold. You can also buy the stationary from another shop.

We do not stock any stationery at school. If you wish to purchase stationery yourself, please see the list of items required below.

Don't worry if you don't have your stationery for the first few days - you can just bring a refill pad or an old exercise book till you get your stationery. please ensure all stationery is named.

Books do not need to be covered but coverseal does keep them neat, together and they do last longer.
