Monday 16th December - normal school day - school finishes at 3pm

Tuesday 17th December - school as per normal for the morning. At 12 noon, all Year 7 students go home for the afternoon. At 1 pm in our school hall is our Year 8 Prizegiving. *If your child is receiving an award you will have already received an invitation via email. Please be seated before the 1 pm starting time.*

Year 8 students conclude their school after the Prizegiving (around 2.45 pm)

Wednesday 18th December - Year 7 students only, school begins at the normal time. Year 7 Prizegiving will commence at 10 am and the year concludes for Year 7 students at the conclusion of their prizegiving (around 11.45 am). *If your child is receiving an award you will have already received an invitation via email. Please be seated before the 10 am starting time.*

Leavers' clothing was distributed today. Year 8 students are permitted to wear theirs for the remainder of the year, except during prizegivings, when all students must wear the correct school uniform.

Te Atatū Intermediate will be closed from 18 December 2024 until 20 January 2025, when the office will reopen for the new school year. Returning whānau will receive start-of-year 2025 information in the new year, including details about stationery requirements (available again via Qizzle) and other key information. The first day of school for Year 8 students in 2025 is Wednesday, 5th February.
