A MESSAGE FROM MR EVANS - TUMUAKI / PRINCIPAL Tēnā koutou katoa o Te Atatū Intermediate whānau.

March is always one of my favourite months as the weather is often settled and warm, but has a touch of the autumn cool that takes away the humidity. It is also the season where we can get some final outside property jobs completed. Today, we have had diggers digging up our cracked and broken concrete in a central part of the school ready for new concrete. It's been great to see the interest this has also created with students watching the process. Once this is completed, our outside projects have all been completed for the year. This will just leave a full administration upgrade, along with refurbishments and upgrade to our Science and Art Rooms which will begin later this year.

TAI Covid update

It seems that we may be seeing light at the end of the tunnel (let's hope it isn't another train) in regards to Covid numbers trending down. This week our numbers have tracked back up to 77% of the students at school from our lowest of 64% last week.

A reminder that Health guidelines from the MOE for **phase 3** state that household members of positive cases **MUST** isolate. Therefore, if anyone in your household tests positive for COVID, you all <u>must isolate</u> <u>for 7 days</u>. (**Day 0** is the day of the positive test- if asymptomatic, or the onset of symptoms. Household contacts now test day 3 and 7) <u>On the 8th day</u>, provided students who have tested positive have no symptoms and are in good health, or have returned negative tests if a household contact, they can return to school.

Please monitor your child's health and keep them home from school if they are unwell.

Teachers have set tasks and work on Google Classroom should your child need to isolate. We also have hard copy packs that we can deliver to local addresses - contact Deputy Principal Kelly Clarke on kelly.c@teatatu.school.nz

Lunch ordering ready this coming week -21 March

We are all now set up with our **lunch ordering system** which will be live **Monday 21 March** for ordering.

Pita Pit will be our school lunch provider and will be available for ordering up to 9am of the day. This will need to be ordered through Kindo - which our school uses for payment options. Please see below for how to access a Kindo account and also how to order a Pita Pit lunch. Lunch orders will be ordered from the Te Atatū store and then delivered to school by 12.20pm - our lunch time.

Once you access the Kindo tool, you will be able to see the menu available for lunch ordering. At present, Zeki's Bakery is unable to process the ordering required, and should the system be worked through, we will be able to add this option. There is the Kindo button on the school website also once Kindo is set up.


ONLINE KINDO SCHOOL SHOP

Ezlunch uses the same software as our Kindo shop. So, if you <u>already have a myKindo account</u> you can simply log in!


