Student News Auckland Athletics Championship On Tuesday, 22 November, the school participated in the Waitakere Athletics Zone Day which was held at Lovelock Track in Mount Roskill. 34 students represented the school. It was a successful event with



16 of them qualifying for the Auckland Championships. These championships were held on **Thursday 1 December** at Massey Park Arena in Papakura.

Our athletes competed in a number of events : **100m and 200m sprints , long jump , high jump and 4 X 100m relay**. As expected, the standard of competition was amazing. Our stand-out performances were :

(i) Aria Costin and Rosa Curtis placing 4th in the 100m finals for Yr 8 and Yr7 girls respectively (ii) Tamilo Ah-Hing winning 1st place in the Yr8 boys' high jump , and

(iii) Rosa Curtis, Awarua Ratahi, Katelyn Wilcox and Summer Bundock winning 2nd position in the Yr 7 girls' relay.
