

## COVID level 3 Newsletter - #16 -Term 4 – Week 7

## Tēnā koutou katoa o whanau o Te Atatū Intermediate

As we look ahead to the new 'traffic light' system which comes into effect from tomorrow, the Ministry of Education has stated that all 'Schools will retain their existing COVID-19 settings until the end of the 2021 calendar year, but guidance will recommend that schools outside of Auckland align their practices with the COVID-19 Protection Framework settings, which will come into effect for all schools from 1 January 2022.'

Therefore, we will be <u>continuing with our alternate Year 7, Year 8 day programme for the remainder of the school year</u>.

Therefore, from next week;

<u>Year 8 days</u> – Monday 6<sup>th</sup> /Wednesday 8<sup>th</sup> / Friday 10<sup>th</sup> / Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> December (last half day ) – ALL EVEN CALENDAR DAYS.

<u>Year 7 days</u> – Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> / Thursday 9<sup>th</sup> / Monday 13<sup>th</sup> / Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> December (last half day) ALL ODD CALENDAR DAYS.

<u>End of Year</u> – As mentioned, we will continue the same alternate day system we are using for the remainder of the year. Unfortunately, there are no events that we are able to run. This does include the Year 8 ball, we understand that this will be a huge disappointment. We will be incorporating a fun day for the year 8s that follows all necessary protocols next Friday 10 December.

The final day for <u>Year 8</u> students will be <u>Tuesday 14<sup>th</sup> December finishing at 12 noon</u>. (Students who have not been back to school, should you wish to collect your desk items – please email your class teacher to arrange to come in on the afternoon of the 14<sup>th</sup> to collect.)

The final day for <u>Year 7</u> students will be <u>Wednesday 15<sup>th</sup> December finishing at 12 noon.</u>

<u>Year 8 mufti</u> – From next week, Year 8s will be able to wear mufti to school for their remaining days of the term. If you were able to consider donating your child's uniform, that would be fantastic. <u>If all donated uniform can be washed, put into a paper bag and given to their class teacher, this would be appreciated.</u>

We will be having our second hand uniform sale on <u>Tuesday 25<sup>th</sup> January 2022</u> for our incoming Year 7 students, and I know many families benefit from this. Year 7s, you will still need to be in school uniform – it will be your turn next year!

<u>Our end of year Prizegiving is going to be via video</u> – This will be pre-recorded and we will play the video to students on their individual last day. Due to the nature of the year, our focus is around class based awards. We will put the links to the videos (separate Year 7 / Year 8) on the website for parents to view.

<u>Chromebooks</u> – Could all Chromebooks that have been lent out to students for online learning be returned to school **Monday 6<sup>th</sup> - Tuesday 7<sup>th</sup> December** to Mr Andrews in the Creative Media room.

Please make sure the student's name and room number are written on a piece of paper and placed inside the Chromebook to assist with the checking off when returned. This will allow Mr Andrews time to organise the computer pods and get them sorted and ready for 2022.

If you have a device, but your child is <u>not</u> attending or returning to school, they can be dropped off at the school office. If for any reason you are unable to return them to school, contact Mr Steve Collins (<u>steve.c@teatatu.school.nz</u>) to arrange the return. Please make sure Chromebook and charger are returned.
