This letter is to inform you that next year in 2020 we will be establishing a new learning concept within our classroom environment. Our focus will be based on the philosophy of 'Authentic learning in Te Ao hurihuri'.

We currently have a setting which encompasses aspects of Te Ao Māori however in 2020 we will develop more programmes based on tikanga, kawa and te reo. Your child has the opportunity to join either Room 4 or Room 8 next year and be part of our new 'Authentic learning in Te Ao Hurihuri' classroom settings. Both teachers are experienced and experts in their field and knowledge of Te Ao Māori me ōna tikanga. Each has worked in either Rumaki Reo or Bilingual education and learning, therefore have the expertise to work with and alongside your tamariki and whānau.

<u>What is required:</u> We would like you to send us your letter of interest first. This can be dropped off to our school office or you can also email: <u>tere.t@teatatu.school.nz</u>.

The end date for processing will be **Friday 22nd November**.

We will make contact with your child's current teacher to discuss their behaviour, learning, strengths and areas of development. We will also be asking them if they have participated in Kapa haka or any aspects of tikanga, kawa or Te Reo. We will then call you to arrange a date for an interview to discuss your application of interest and the expectations set for students and whānau.
